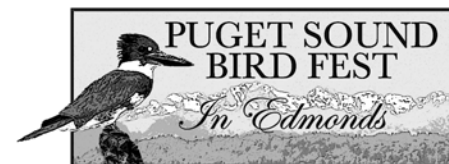

**a**-Abundant **c**-Common  
**u**-Uncommon  
**o**-Occasional **r**-Rare  
**x**-Accidental

### Definitions:

a-abundant: likely to be seen in good numbers  
c-common: usually seen in proper habitat  
u-uncommon: seen regularly in small numbers  
o-occasional: irregular occurrence  
r-rare: rarely seen, but more than two records  
x-accidental: one or two records
